

# MaineDOT's Park & Ride

## Policy Changes Go Into Effect November 1, 2015

The Park & Ride Program is designed to encourage commuter ridesharing across Maine. Due to a number of factors, we are changing some rules and want to make you aware of the changes. Beginning November 1:

- We are prohibiting trailers, or any vehicles longer than 24 feet, in MaineDOT Park & Ride Lots.
- Parking for more than seven days is never allowed.
- During snow season, November 1–April 30, users can't leave their vehicles for more than 24 hours. We can't predict when snow will fall and must be able to clear and sand the lots

for commuters.

In our effort to foster ridesharing, we must implement policies that work for all MaineDOT Park & Ride Lots across the state. Maine Turnpike Authority's Park and Ride Lots may have different rules which are posted on site. [View a list of affected Park and Ride Lots below.](#)

<b>Dixfield</b>	US Route 2, municipal parking lot located at the rear of the Town Office and Town Library
<b>East Lebanon</b>	US Route 202, Depot Road and Lower Cross Road
<b>Edgecomb</b>	US Route 1, at Dodge Road
<b>Farmington</b>	US Route 2, State Route 4, and Intervale Road
<b>Freeport</b>	US Route 1, 0.2 mile south of Desert Road (across from Coastline Inn)
<b>Freeport</b>	US Route 1, 1.7 mile south of Desert Road (across from the Eagle Motel)
<b>Gardiner</b>	I-295 Exit 49, on US Route 201 (Gardiner Industrial Park)
<b>Gorham</b>	US Route 114
<b>Lisbon Falls</b>	State Route 196, near State Route 125 along the abandoned MCRR
<b>Mechanic Falls</b>	State Route 121, at Depot Square Transportation Center
<b>Medway</b>	State Route 157, at Irving Big Stop
<b>New Gloucester</b>	Sabbath Day Road, State Route 26
<b>Nobleboro</b>	US Route 1, at Winslow Hill Road, next to Town Office
<b>Portland</b>	I-295 Exit 7, Marginal Way near Franklin Arterial

<b>Randolph</b>	State Route 27, north of State Route 126 intersection
<b>Rockland</b>	Rockland District High School at 400 Broadway
<b>Rome</b>	State Route 27 and 225
<b>Sabattus</b>	State Route 126 and Sawyer Road
<b>Saco</b>	Industrial Park Road, near Maine Tpk Exit 36
<b>Saco</b>	State Route 112 and the discontinued Maine Turnpike exit (Old Exit 5)
<b>Shapleigh</b>	Back Road, next to Town Hall
<b>Shapleigh</b>	State Route 11, across from Fire Department
<b>Skowhegan</b>	US Route 2 and State Route 150
<b>South Portland</b>	Maine Tpk Exit 45, on Turnpike Spur near toll plaza
<b>Thomaston</b>	US Route 1, Valley Street behind business block nearest to the Lura Libby Elementary School
<b>Topsham</b>	I-295 Exit 37, at Topsham Fair Mall parking lot (near Home Depot)
<b>Waldoboro</b>	US Route 1 and West Main Street (Old Route 1)
<b>West Peru</b>	State Route 108 and Hammond Ferry Road
<b>Westbrook</b>	US Route 302 at Prides Corner (Four Seasons Bingo Complex)
<b>Westbrook</b>	Maine Tpk Exit 47 Rand Road, at Westbrook Arterial and Larrabee Road
<b>Winthrop</b>	10 Lake Street at St. Francis Catholic Church
<b>Yarmouth</b>	US Route 1 and Exit 15 on I-295 (north/southbound)
<b>Yarmouth</b>	I-295 Exit 17, US Route 1 (Visitor Information Center)
